

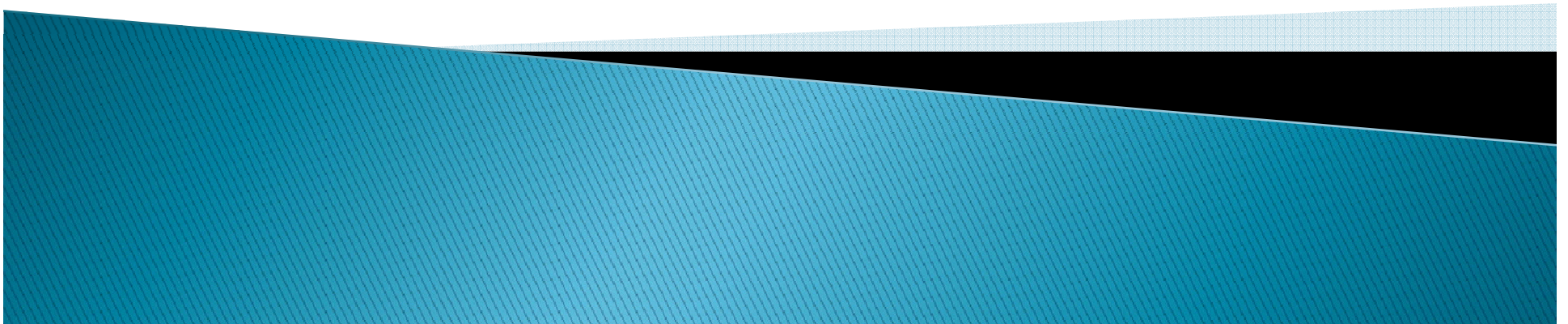

CONSTRAINTS

- ✓ Non-revision of penalties after 1988:
- ✓ Issuance of Driving Licence
- ✓ Issuance of fitness certificates for commercial vehicles
- ✓ Increasing number of private vehicles on the roads
- ✓ Limited availability of public transport
- ✓ Goods vehicles passing through the city of Delhi

Crackdown on Drunken Driving

- ✓ Prosecution : 2010 – 8,468
2011– 12,550
- ✓ 1,908 Driving Licenses suspended
- ✓ 2,250 imprisonments
- ✓ In 51 cases imprisonment for 10 days and above



Impact of intensive drunken driving action

- ✓ Reduced incident of drunken driving in the city
- ✓ Increased awareness among the road users
- ✓ Reduced accidents by cars, two-wheelers & commercial vehicles
- ✓ Reduced self-accidents

Commercial Vehicles disciplined

- ✓ Supreme Court violations prosecutions :
2010 – 22,447
2011 – 29,314



Decline in accidents by commercial vehicles

2010 – 619

2011 – 497

(upto 15th Sept.)

Manning of traffic intersections in peak hours

- ✓ There is better road discipline if a policeman is present at the intersection
- ✓ Reduction of fatal accidents in all 24 fortnights of 2010

Disciplining Public Transport

- ✓ DTC Prosecutions : 2010– 1,972 2011 – 4,303
- ✓ Criminal cases for forged permits of blueline buses.
- ✓ Increase in accidents by DTC a cause for concern



Safer carrying of School Children

- ✓ Prosecutions : 2010 – 618
2011 – 4,289



Prosecution by chase and challan

✓ Prosecutions : 2010 – 7,82,036
2011 – 11,88,038



Crackdown on Gramin Sewa violating rules

Prosecutions : 2010- Nil 2011 – 38,194



Crackdown on unauthorised plying of Tractors

Reduction in fatal accidents 2010 – 39
2011 – 26

Prosecutions : 2010- 3,425 2011 – 5,625



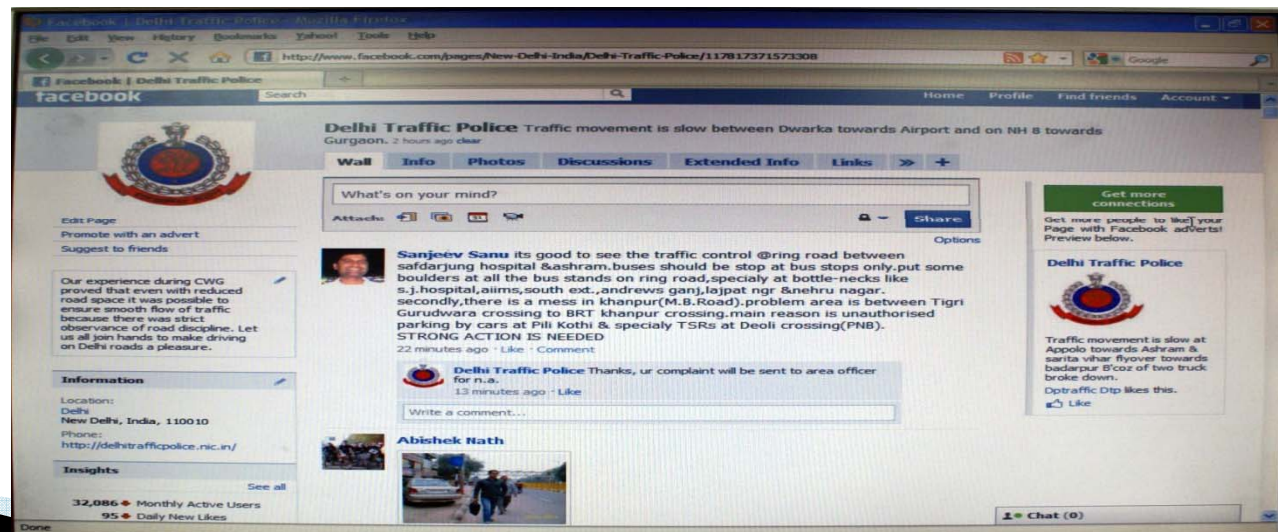
